Crayon et assemblage combustible


Les pastilles d'uranium sont enfilées dans des tubes en métal de 4 m de long dont les extrémités sont bouchées, pour constituer ce que l'on appelle des crayons. Ces crayons sont regroupés par lots dans des assemblages combustibles, eux-mêmes placés dans le cœur du réacteur pour le faire fonctionner.
